- Our efforts begin while a project is still in the planning stage. We take advantage of all Dodge reports, Construction Journals, and Reed reports. - We routinely make up parts boxes for the projects we secure. As a project nears completion, we personally deliver these parts boxes, and train the maintenance people on how to perform routine maintenance. Our contact information is affixed inside the parts box, and any time the maintenance staff needs help, or additional parts, we handle these requests.

This service has proven to be a tremendous selling tool. Plumbing contractors love the fact that during their warranty period they will not have to visit a project to handle maintenance issues. All of our customers realize that this puts money directly into their pockets.

Within 24 hours we were on site. The RSL team, with the help of a few plumbers we picked up at the union hall, removed the handles and tightened the packing on all 465 faucets within 6 hours.

The union plumber on the job said in his forty years on the job he had never seen a quicker, or better organized response, to a problem.
